

APPEAL TO ALL RIDERS:

As with all trials clubs, Macc Trials events are able to take place due to the continued efforts from a team of regular volunteers who strive to make each event run as smoothly as possible. However, hiccups can and do occur, hence the reason for this appeal.

We would like to form a “pool” or “bank” of willing riders and/or friends who are prepared to help *periodically* throughout the year, in order to give our regular team some respite, and to continue the smooth running of our trials.

Duties include

- marking out sections (*usually the day before or when convenient*)
- finding observers (*always a problem!*)
- route marking
- observing
- collecting all section / route markers after a trial and
- other general clearing up ie gates closed, rubbish etc - *most important so as to retain the venue.*

Volunteers would be rewarded with *free* trial entries, fees being met from club funds.

Also, you will have noticed that at all trials there is a regular batch of people willing to observe and stand in all weathers enabling you to have a good day's ride. These people are an invaluable asset to the club - without them there would be no trial! Consequently *free* trial entries are available to riders who bring along an observer on the day. We give all observers a contribution to refreshment at the regular “Butty Van” as a token of thanks on your behalf. The “Butty Van” was introduced with both riders and observers in mind and is now a positive feature at our trials.
