Expert winner Chris Pearson had an exceptional ride on section 5 with the only clean and a dab, an awkward and slippery approach to the final climb that perplexed all his rivals. Chris then secured his win with another unrivalled ride on section 13.

Over 40's rider Mike Roberts easily won the Inter Route outright with a consistent performance that put him in a class of his own.

Over 50's rider Scott Rowland won the Clubman Route outright too with another exhibition ride to repeat the achievement gained at the Hipwell Trial just up the road six days earlier.
